KRC D is recruiting Power Plant Manager candidates for the Jeff L. Taylor Pine Flat Power Plant. This is a management level opportunity reporting directly to the Deputy General Manager of Power Operations. The Power Plant Manager is responsible for the overall maintenance and operation of the District's hydroelectric power plant at Pine Flat Dam.

**THE IDEAL CANDIDATE**

The ideal candidate for this position will be a person who has knowledge of:

- Functional characteristics of generating units and auxiliary machinery, busses, switches, control circuits, valves, spillways, metering, and water control devices
- Fundamentals of electricity, hydraulics, and hydrology
- Maintenance procedures, material, tools and equipment used in the installation, modification, maintenance and operation of power generation facilities and associated equipment
- Engineering principles as applied to electrical and mechanical maintenance of hydroelectric facilities
- Operating characteristics of heavy rotating machinery and auxiliary equipment
- Chemical properties of materials used in maintenance work
- Principles of employee supervision, development, training, and performance evaluation

**SIGNIFICANT DUTIES**

- Develop and maintain the annual operating budget for the facility and approve expenditures relating to operation and maintenance of the plant in accordance with the developed budget
- Develop operations and maintenance schedules that ensure optimal plant performance and reliability and are in accordance with District policies, standards, and practices
- Maintain compliance with environmental and NERC/WECC requirements
- Direct and manage District personnel and contractors engaged in plant operations and maintenance activities to ensure compliance with policies, procedures, contracts, permits, and/or regulations
- Prepare monthly reports detailing significant plant activities and updates on the facility operating plan, including the preparation of budget variance reports
- Assess and recommend plant upgrades and enhancements that would improve the reliability, performance, safety, and/or environmental readiness of the plant including cost benefit analysis to District management
- Oversee the planning and implementation of maintenance and outage activities; provide outage reports to District Management summarizing significant events of the outage

**EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE**

Any combination of education and experience that will provide the necessary knowledge and abilities will be considered acceptable.

*Education:* Equivalent to completion of the twelfth grade

*Experience:* Six years of increasingly responsible experience in the maintenance and operation of gas or hydro power generation plants and four years supervising employees
